












Building a Community



Jetting Started

Common name: Dwarf Sunflower "Sonja"

Latin name: Helianthus annuus



1. Prepare your soil in the pots or pick and prepare the sunniest garden space in your yard. (If anyone has questions about creating a garden space please send us a direct message!)

Your plants will need 6-8 hours of direct sun a day – if you are gardening inside give them your sunniest windowsill.

The more sun your plants get the happier they will be and the more flowers they will produce.

2. Plant 2 seeds ½" deep in your pot or spaced 18" apart if you are direct sowing into your garden.

You can use the chopsticks provided to poke the hole!

3. Water your seeds, but don't completely soak the soil.

Your seeds want to stay evenly moist, but not water-logged.

Once your seeds are planted and in their sunny spot you will want to check the soil every day to ensure it is keeping enough moisture to help your seeds germinate and turn into seedlings.

Common name: Dragon Tongue Bush Snap Bean

Latin name: Phaseolus vulgaris

1. Prepare your soil in the pots or pick and prepare the sunniest garden space in your yard. (If anyone has questions about creating a garden space please send us a direct message!)

Your plants will need at least 5-6 hours of direct sun a day – if you are gardening inside give them your sunniest windowsill.



The more sun your plants get the happier they will be, and the more bean pods they will produce.

2. Plant 2 seeds 1" deep in your pot or 1 seed spaced 3" apart if you are direct sowing into your garden.

You can use the chopsticks provided to poke the hole!

3. Water your seeds, but don't completely soak the soil.

Your seeds want to stay evenly moist, but not water-logged.

Once your seeds are planted and in their sunny spot you will want to check the soil every day to ensure it is keeping enough moisture to help your seeds germinate and turn into seedlings.

Zero Waste Tarden Kits

Sheilah and Shayna both do their best to pursue zero-waste/reduce-waste lifestyles. The kits we have provided follow along this idea as much as possible:

- Paper or Reusable bags instead of plastic ones
- 🧩 Wooden and metal spade, instead of plastic
- Printed on recycled papers
- Paper bags/envelopes for packing soil and seeds
- Wooden plant markers
- Bamboo chopsticks
- Plastic pots that can be recycled at any Superstore

So, although our kits may not contain lots of items, we purposely chose to only give items that are needed or eco-friendly/reduced waste.

Zero-waste is not that difficult to start doing, and we would love to hear everyone's ideas of how they reduce waste!




Little Gardeners Club Colouring Book

We cannot wait to see how colourful and beautiful everyone's pictures will look!


